The International Baccalaureate (IB) Program provides a comprehensive rigorous education emphasizing critical thinking with an international perspective. A student can earn a full diploma by completing courses in six areas of study – English, Foreign Language, Social Studies, Science, Mathematics, and Fine Arts and Electives. In addition, diploma students must engage in community service (CAS), individual research (extended essay), and a theory of knowledge course. IB courses are open to highly motivated students who are required to complete a series of internal and external assessments. Students may receive college credit based upon the IB examination scores.
